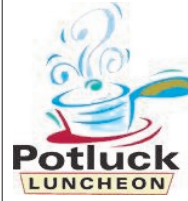


Diocesan Mass

Lunch Will be Served!

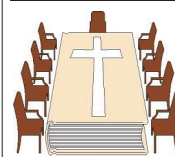
