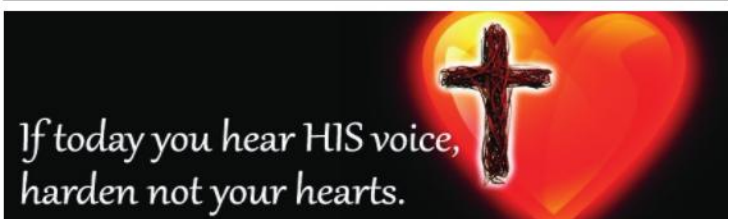
Salesian Cooperator
