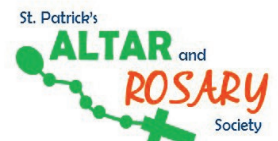
Mark your calendars for the 2017 Ecumenical Service week. On January 19th, we will host the Ecumenical Service. Come join us for worship as a community of faith!
