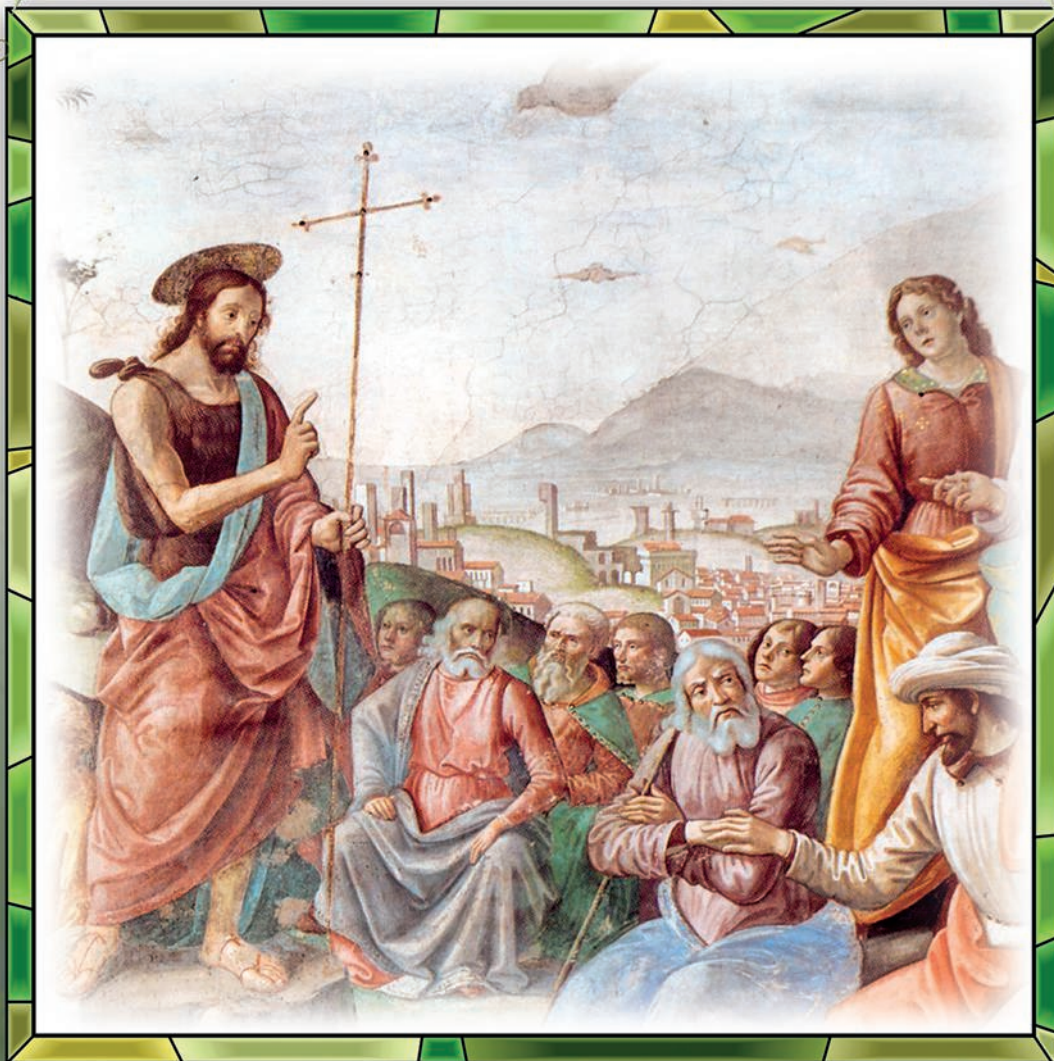

**Financial Peace**

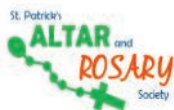

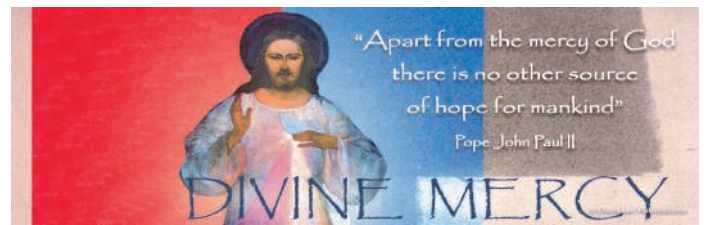
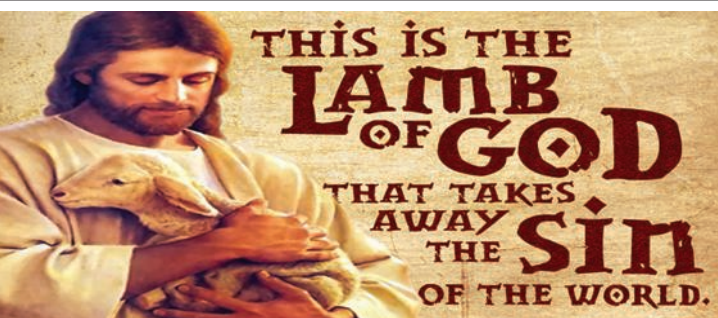
