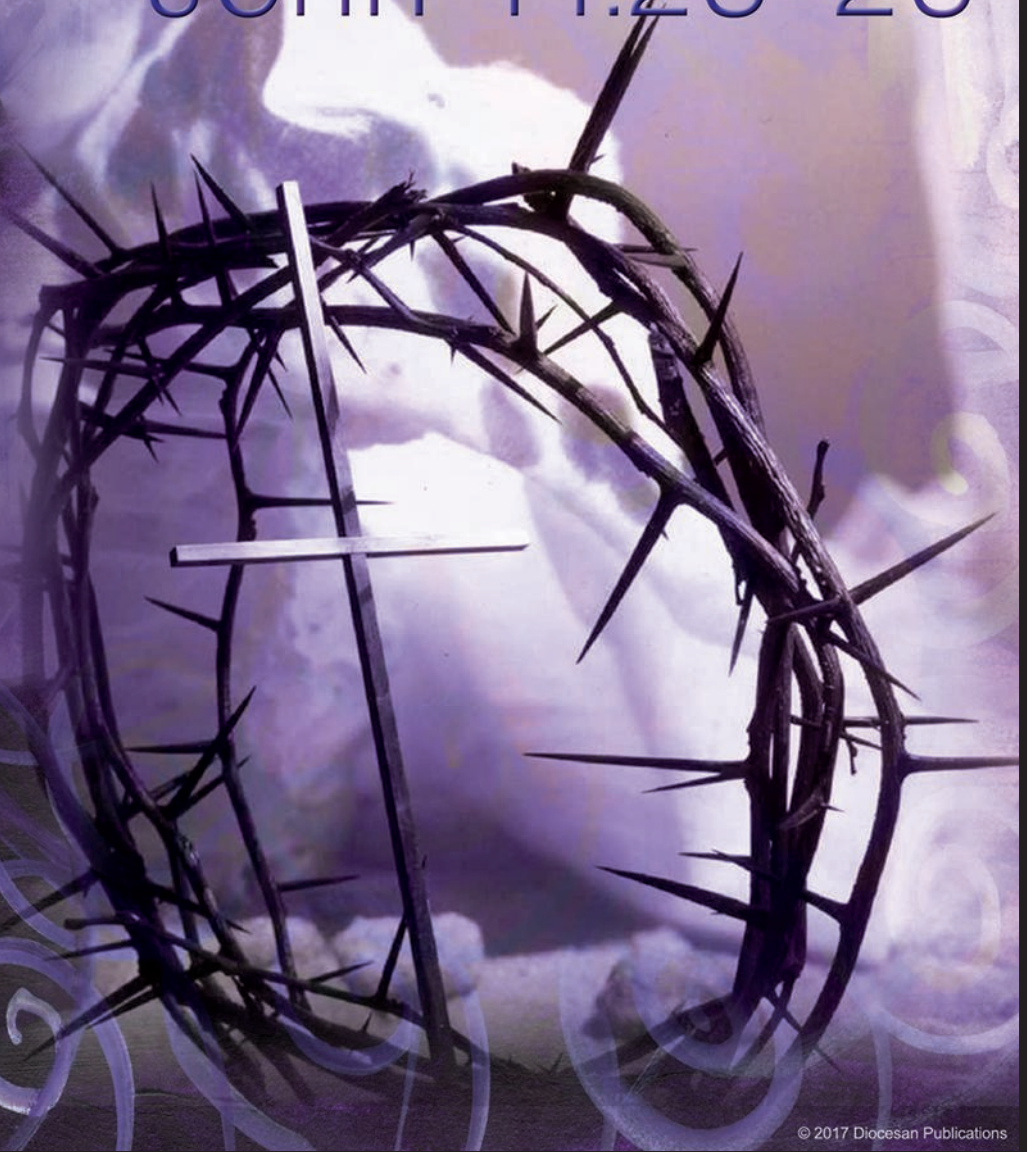

The sign up sheet for mass servers is in the back of the church for the month of **April**. Your schedule will be in the bulletin and on the website. Thank you!

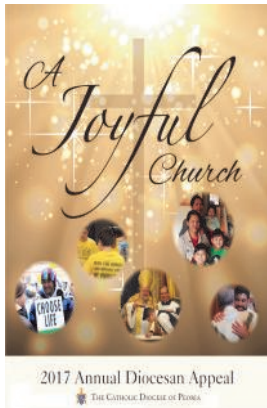


Easter Flower Memorials
