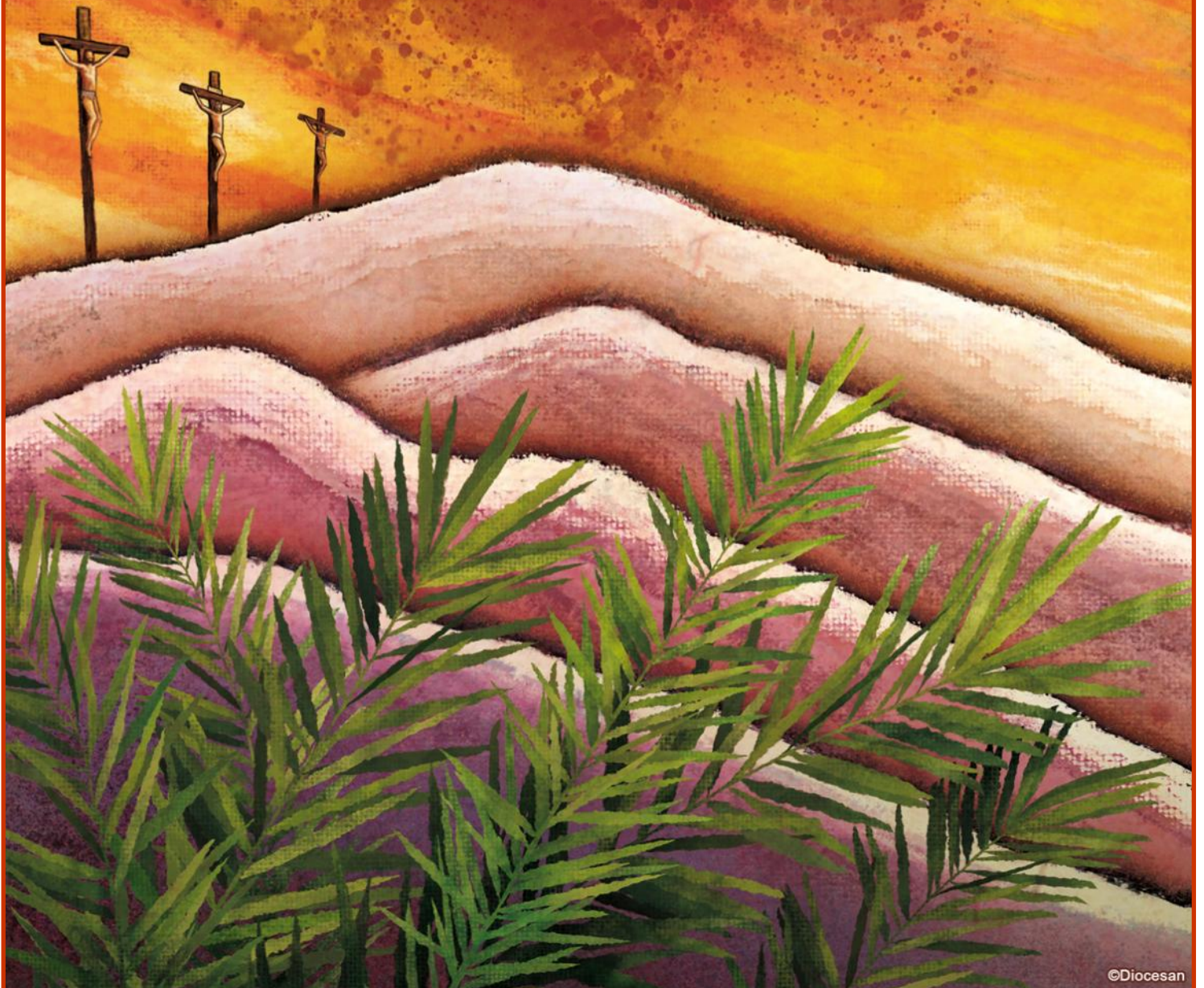

WHAT: The annual "Way of the Cross for Victims of Abortion" service will be held outside abortion facilities nationwide. This moving prayer service provides another opportunity for us to gather in solidarity as pro-lifers nationwide contemplate the suffering of Jesus Christ at our own modern-day Golgotha, the abortion facility.

Prayer booklets including Scripture readings and group prayers will be provided. These prayers follow what is known as The Stations of the Cross, which depict 14 events in the Passion of Jesus Christ, beginning with Jesus being condemned to death and ending with His body being laid in a tomb.
