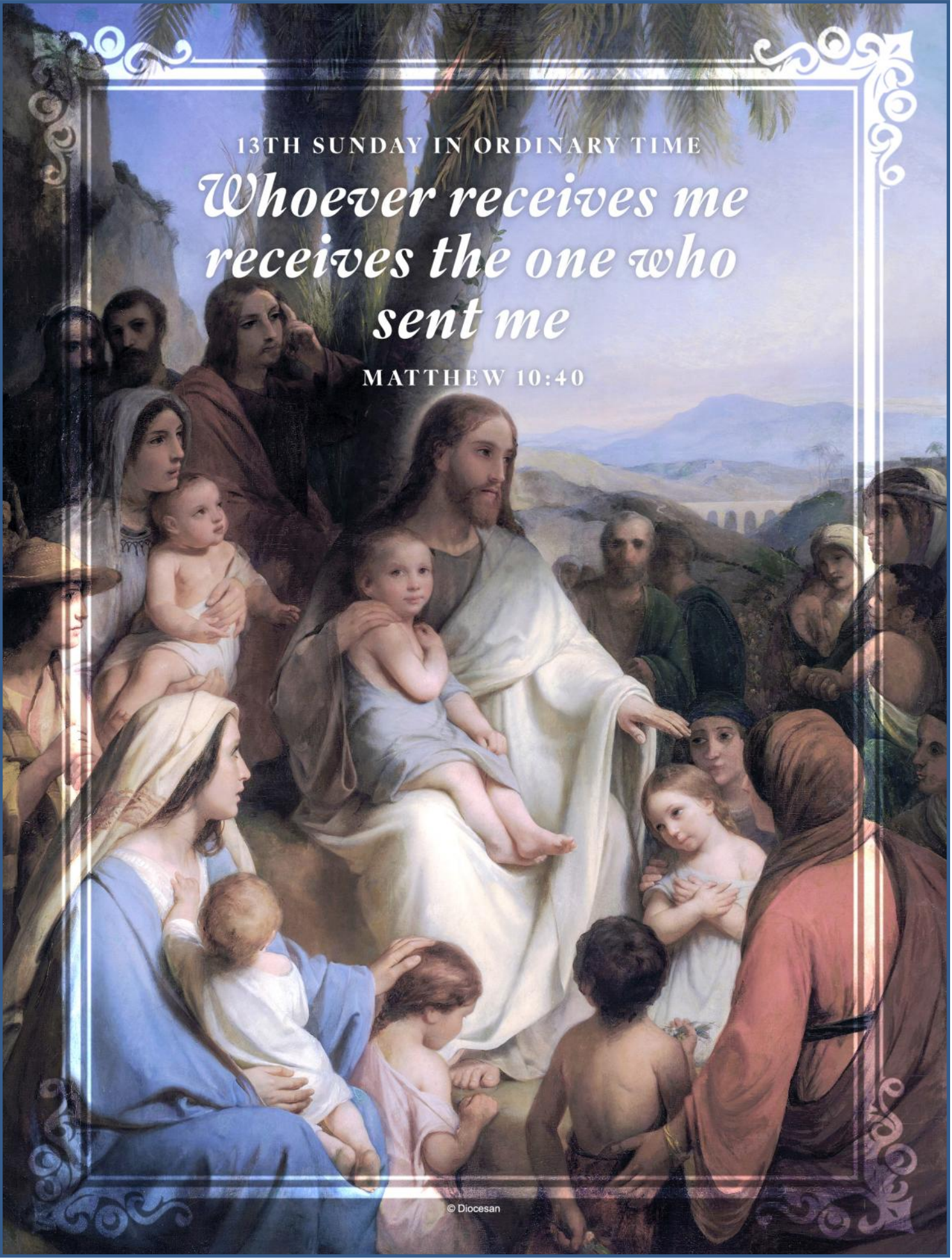

Celebrate UV safety month during our sunniest month of the year!
