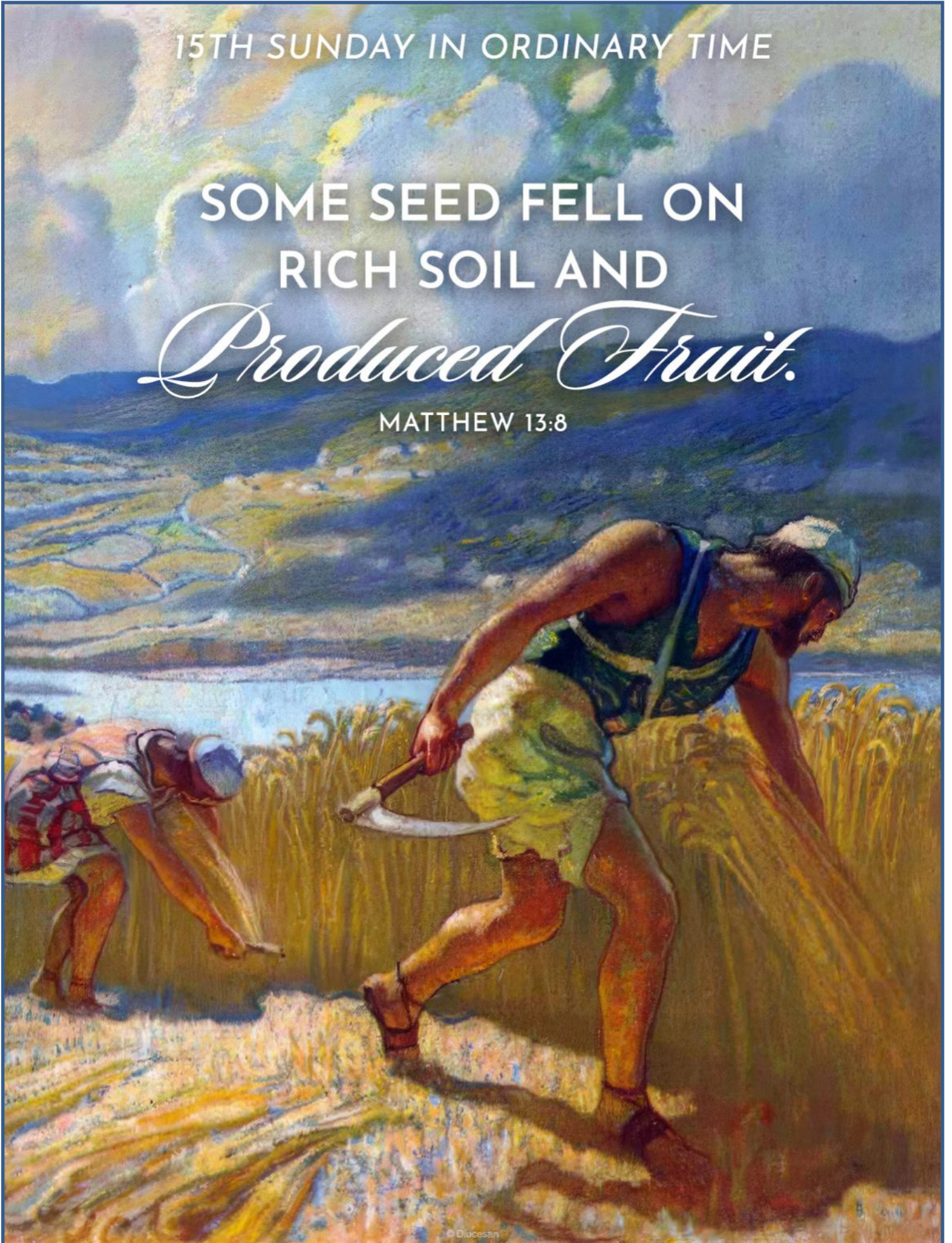

FAITH COMMUNITY HEALTH**Summer Emergency Travel Kit**

Summer brings long road trips, family vacations, and outdoor adventures—but it also brings heat waves, severe storms, and crowded highways. A well-prepared emergency travel kit can turn an unexpected delay or breakdown into a manageable inconvenience instead of a crisis. Packing a few essentials helps keep travelers safe, comfortable, and ready for the unexpected.

Core Items Every Traveler Should Carry**Hydration and Heat Protection**

- Water supply — at least several bottles per person; consider a larger jug for longer trips.
- Cooling towels or bandanas — can reduce body temperature if stranded in heat.
- Sunscreen and lip balm — SPF protection for prolonged outdoor exposure.
- Wide-brim hat or lightweight sunshade — First Aid and Personal Care
- Basic first aid kit — bandages, antiseptic wipes, gauze, tweezers, and gloves.
- Over-the-counter pain relievers — Acetaminophen or ibuprofen
- Allergy supplies — Diphenhydramine or loratidine.
- Hand sanitizer and wipes — for hygiene when restrooms are unavailable.
- Personal medications — stored in a cool, dry place.
- Emergency contact list — written on paper in case devices fail.
- Medical information card

Keeping the Kit Ready

A summer emergency kit works best when it's maintained. Check expiration dates, replace used items, and store everything in an easy-to-reach container. Keeping the kit in the trunk ensures it's always available.
