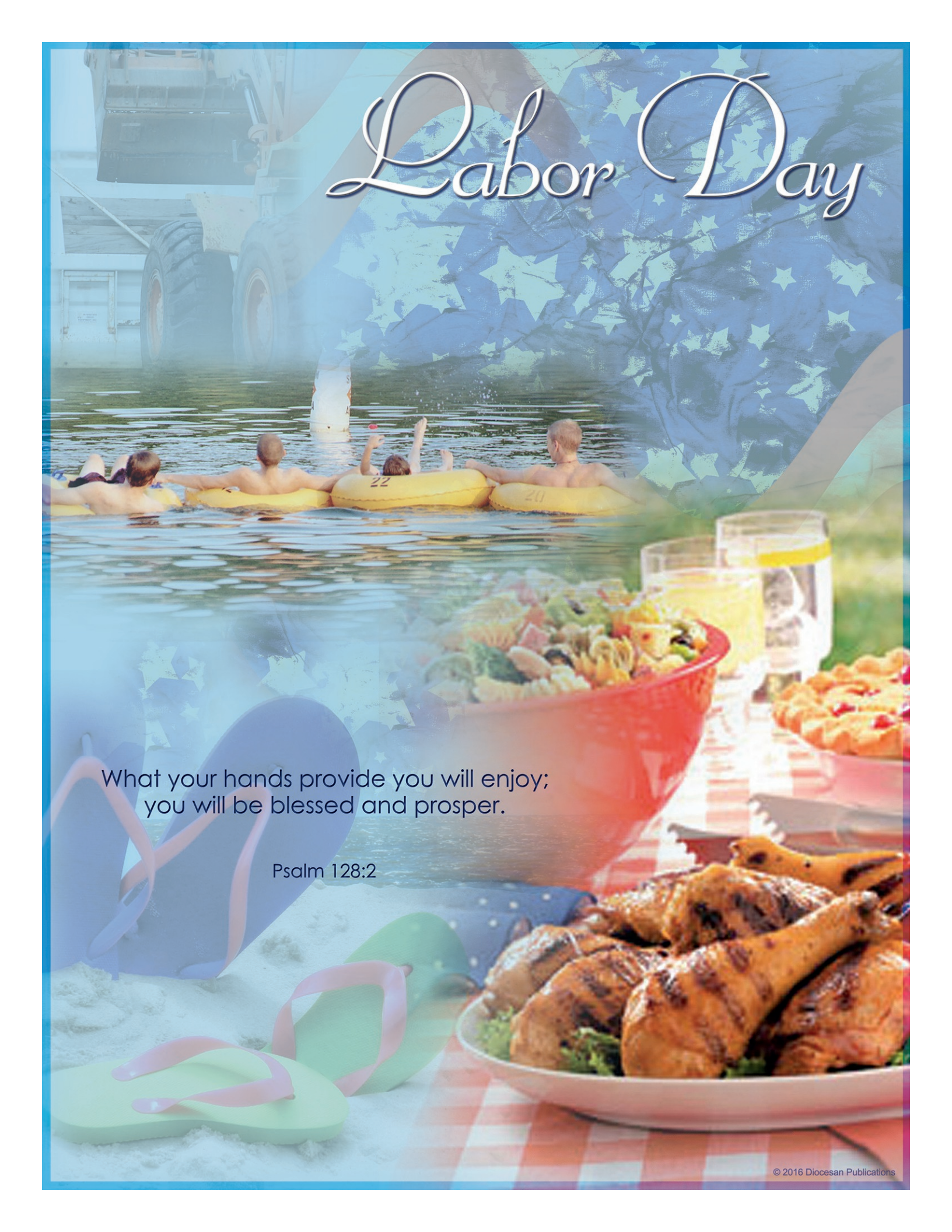

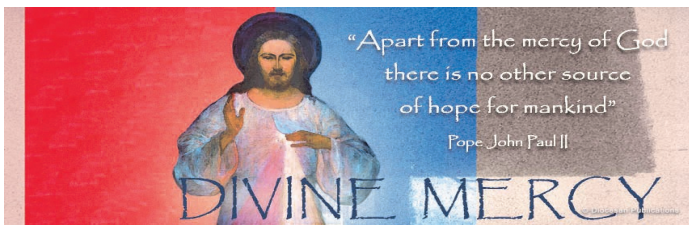

Liturgical Roles

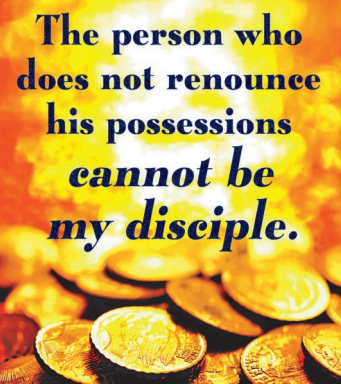
